Dear Supervisors Cobb, Gaulke, Hanson:

Citizens for Education in Town Governance respectfully requests a brief update on several topics at the town board's first meeting in March.

- 1. Last May Mr. Gaulke said he would draft a policy/procedure statement on how board members and others can get items on a town board meeting agenda. What is the status of the statement?
- 2. Last May and June, supervisors Cobb and Hanson asked the road crew foreman to prepare a five-year schedule/plan for road maintenance and construction. What is the status of the schedule/plan?
- 3. Last May, Supervisor Cobb suggested that the town's zoning administrator report to the board every few months. When will the zoning administrator report on data for 2021?
- 4. Last December/January, the town board noted that forums on strategic planning would be held to solicit public input. When will the forums be held?
- 5. At the board's direction, Mr. Gaulke sent a letter dated November 8, 2021 to the owner of the Raven Lake property enquiring whether acreage is available for sale (to be used as a site for construction of a new fire station). What is the response to the letter?
- 6. When and where will the town board hold the 2022 annual meeting?
