January 10, 2024 Special Town Board Meeting

The Special Town Board meeting of the Lac du Flambeau Town Board was called to order by Chairman Gaulke at 5:00 p.m. Supervisor Hanson, Supervisor Cobb, Treasurer Schwartz and Clerk Susan Schoonover were present.

This meeting was properly posted, and the media notified as required by law.

<u>Approval of Agenda</u>: Motion by Supervisor Hanson, seconded by Supervisor Cobb to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

<u>Public Comment on Agenda Items</u>: Road Foreman Pete Kolzow commented on the Longevity Pay agenda item stating it was typically paid at the end of the year and was not paid in 2023. He stated it had been in effect for approximately 30 years, not a specific budget line but taken out of payroll according to a document.

Jim Martin commented on the Easement issue agenda item inquiring about the status of the FOIA request from August and requesting an update.

<u>Discussion: Tribal Police Chief TJ Bill and Investigator George Hopfensperger</u>: Officers explained with the beginning of COVID how drug trafficking had changed course and the impacts that were noticed locally by August of 2022. After a demonstrative discussion, they informed the public of the multiple agencies they partner with all over the State and Federally. The Tribal Police Department has now absorbed the Tribal Emergency Management Department and will be working to keep the public informed.

<u>Discussion: Supervisor Hanson regarding Future Planning:</u> Supervisor Hanson urges the Board to commit to a long-term financial plan. He suggests UW Extension may have resources.

<u>Action Regarding Closed Session:</u> Chairman Gaulke announced that with regard to item 15 Road Easement issue that the Board will be preparing the monthly letter to the Tribe.

Action regarding item 16, motion by Supervisor Cobb to refer the issue to the Vilas County District Attorney for review, seconded by Supervisor Hanson. Moton carried.

Action regarding item 16 Longevity Pay, motion by Supervisor Hanson to not issue these payments for 2023 but to develop a performance pay policy in 2024, seconded by Supervisor Cobb. Motion carried.
