## **October 5, 2022 Regular Town Board Meeting**

The regular meeting of the Town Board was called to order at 1:00 p.m. by Chairman Gaulke. Supervisor Cobb, Treasurer Irene Messinger and Deputy Clerk Susan Schoonover were present. Supervisor Hanson was excused.

Others present: Norm Wetzel, Roberta Gast, Jim Sommerfeldt, Bill McCutchin, and John Bernard.

This meeting was properly posted and the media notified as required by law.

Pledge of Allegiance.

Moment of Silence for the passing of David Diver.

Motion by Supervisor Cobb, seconded by Chairman Gaulke to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

Motion by Supervisor Cobb, seconded by Chairman Gaulke to approve vouchers of the General Fund Account 2559-2574 & ACH 1280-1281. Motion carried.

Motion by Supervisor Cobb, seconded by Chairman Gaulke to approve the minutes of the Regular Special Town Board Meeting held September 21, 2022. Motion carried.

Motion by Supervisor Cobb, seconded by Chairman Gaulke to approve the minutes of the Special Town Board Meeting held September 28, 2022. Motion carried.

**Treasurers Report:** Treasurer Messinger presented her treasurers report. Total in our regular accounts as of 09/30/22 \$1,527,153.57. Ambulance Fund as of 09/30/22 \$602,498.70. Reserve account \$243,079.15. Motion by Supervisor Cobb, seconded by Chairman Gaulke to approve the treasurer's report. Motion carried.

**Public Comment:** Bill McCutchin questioned changed meeting times and significance of a special meeting versus adding agenda items to a regular meeting. Chairman Gaulke explained that larger discussions such as the Firehouse Construction Project will be scheduled as special meetings as the discussions could possibly be lengthier. Further explanation was given that community members had asked about meetings during the day for the winter months which would be advantageous for safer travel. Sign in sheets demonstrate that the time of meeting has no impact on attendance.

**Appreciation of local volunteers for Fire Prevention Week 10/09-10/15/22:** Chairman Gaulke expressed appreciation for all volunteers. Supervisor Cobb mentioned that we should have a cook out to interact with the community for appreciation and to raise awareness.

**3rd Quarter Zoning Update:** Chairman Gaulke read the totals for permits issued, permit dollars collected and estimated tax revenue.

**ARPA Expenditures Update:** Chairman Gaulke reviewed the previously approved allocations and budgeted amounts as well as what has been paid out to date. Jim

Sommerfeldt questioned any ARPA money being used for broadband collaboration. Supervisor Cobb reiterated our intention of collaborating with the Tribe, once broadband is brought to the township.

Motion by Supervisor Cobb, seconded by Chairman Gaulke to adjourn at 1:20 P.M. Motion carried.
