

## **November 2, 2022 Regular Town Board Meeting**

The regular meeting of the Town Board was called to order at 1:00 p.m. by Chairman Gaulke. Supervisor Cobb, Supervisor Hanson, Treasurer Irene Messinger and Deputy Clerk Susan Schoonover were present.

Motion by Supervisor Hanson, seconded by Supervisor Cobb to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

Motion by Supervisor Hanson, seconded by Supervisor Cobb to approve vouchers of the General Fund Account 2606-2640 & ACH 1284-1288. Chairman Gaulke abstained. Motion carried.

**Treasurers Report:** Treasurer Messinger presented her treasurers report. Total in our regular accounts as of 10/31/22 is \$1,535,792.12. Ambulance Fund as of 10/31/22 is \$609,564.94. Reserve account \$243,279.50. Motion by Supervisor Hanson, seconded by Supervisor Cobb to approve the treasurer's report. Motion carried.

**Public Comment:** None.

**Oneida County Ambulance Service Contract:** Chairman Gaulke provided an update that the contract was initially reviewed by Attorney Harrold, however he had requested some clarifications from Oneida County. Since these had not been secured, the attorney's review is not yet complete. Supervisor Cobb requested a special meeting to be set for November 21, 2022 at 1:00 pm with our attorney present to discuss his review. Additionally, she stated we needed to look at the numbers from 2021 to have an idea of where we are. Supervisor Hanson had concerns that we were being treated like other towns, yet have our own department.
