

December 6, 2023 Regular Town Board Meeting

The Regular meeting of the Town Board was called to order by Chairman Gaulke at 5:30 p.m. Supervisor Hanson, Supervisor Cobb, Treasurer Schwartz and Clerk Susan Schoonover were present.

Approval of Agenda: Motion by Supervisor Cobb, seconded by Supervisor Hanson to approve the agenda. Motion carried.

Public Comment on Agenda Items: Dennis Pearson addressed the Board regarding the State Uniformity Clause, devaluation impact vs permit fee price. Mary Possin spoke as to the resources available via Congress for a solution as this is beyond the scope of the Town's ability to solve. Joseph Hunt described the 2007 abandonment of Big Thunder Lane with documentation and the new road that was built on private land. Dave Miess reiterated the owner's use of the new road and abandonment of the Old Big Thunder Lane. Sandy Schloesser spoke to her unknown easement issues via BIA, Real Estate agents and previous owner not acknowledging any issues.

Discussion: Tower Update: Chairman Gaulke gave a report on the recent events. Supervisor Cobb questioned why income was less than 2023. Chairman to follow on contract negotiations with Vilas County.

Discussion/Possible Action OCEMS Contract 2024: Discussion. Motion by Supervisor Cobb, seconded by Supervisor Hanson to sign the 2024 contract under protest.

Convene Into Closed Session: Motion by Supervisor Hanson, seconded by Supervisor Cobb to move into closed session pursuant to Wi Stats 19:85(e). RE: Road Easement Issue. Roll call vote: Supervisor Hanson aye; Supervisor Cobb aye; Chairman Gaulke aye. We are in closed session.

Reconvene Into Open Session: Motion by Supervisor Hanson, seconded by Supervisor Cobb to return to open session. Roll call vote: Supervisor Hanson aye; Supervisor Cobb aye; Chairman Gaulke aye. We are in open session.

Action Regarding Closed Session: Chairman Gaulke reports on action from closed session to include a letter will accompany the 12/12/23-01/12/24 payment, to be reviewed by legal, acknowledging the 12/1/23 letter from President Johnson. A Special Town Board Meeting will be held 12/13/23, for closed session, to confer with legal regarding recent activity.
