Presentation of Firehouse Construction Consultants: Five Bugles:

Five Bugles a consultant firm specializing in firehouse construction was present for today's meeting. They explained how their company puts together plans and phases for new firehouse construction. They showed the board examples of other firehouses they have constructed in various cities/towns in Wisconsin and outlying states. The board will take this information into consideration when a decision needs to be made.

ARPA Funds: Chairman Gaulke explained to the board the ARPA Fund deadline of April 30, 2022 to submit their plans. It was explained that at this time the funding uses have not been finalized and that when submitting the report it can be stated as such.
